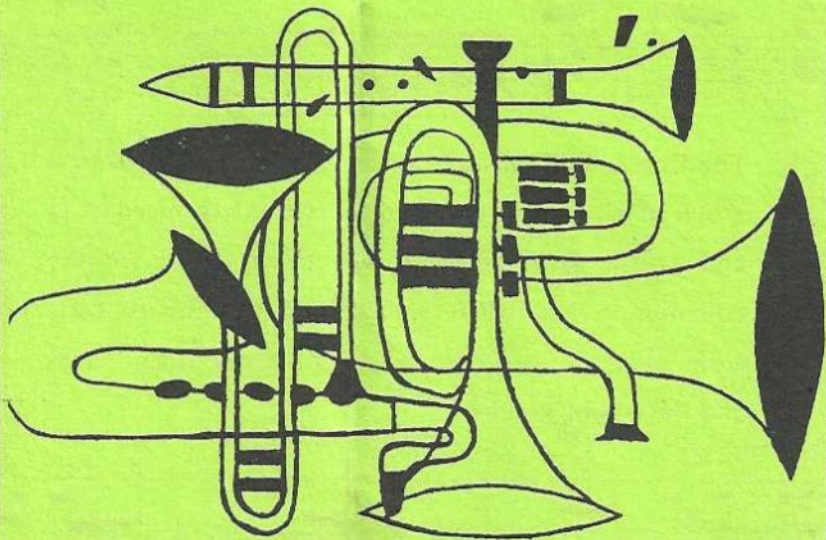


THE PASADENA MUNICIPAL CONCERT BAND
